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Dear Parent(s):

If you are interested in a Home Education Program for your child(ren), you will need to submit the notarized attached affidavit to Salisbury Township School District prior to the commencement of the home education program and annually thereafter on or before August 1st. The affidavit must include evidence that the child has been immunized and has received the health and medical services required for the students of the child's age or grade level.

Furthermore, the supervisor of the home education program will be required to submit the name of each evaluator for each student. An evaluator must review the work in the portfolio and a written evaluation must be completed. The name of the evaluator(s) and the report(s) must be submitted to the school district by June 30th. AFFIDAVIT OF THE SUPERVISOR OF A HOME EDUCATION PROGRAM

The compulsory education section of the Pennsylvania school code states:

It is the policy of the Commonwealth to preserve the primary right of the parent or parents, or person or persons in loco parentis to a child, to choose the education and training for such child.

Before me the undersigned notary republic, this day personally appeared _____, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and says:

I attest that I am a parent or guardian or other person having legal custody of the child or children listed below, that I am responsible for the provision of instruction in his/her/their home education program in which the following courses are offered in the English language for a minimum of one hundred eighty (180) days of instruction or a minimum of nine hundred ninety (990) hours of instruction at the secondary school level, and that the home education program is otherwise in compliance with the provisions of the Public School Code:

At the ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LEVEL the following courses shall be taught: English, to include spelling, reading, and writing; arithmetic; science; geography; history of the United States and Pennsylvania; civics; safety education, including regular and continuous instruction in the dangers and prevention of fires; health and physiology; physical education; music; and art.

At the SECONDARY SCHOOL LEVEL the following courses shall be taught: English, to include language, literature, speech and composition; science; geography; social studies, to include civics, world history, history of the United States and Pennsylvania; mathematics, to include general mathematics, algebra, and geometry; art; music; physical education; health; and safety education, including regular and continuous instruction in the dangers and prevention of fires. Other courses may be included at the discretion of the supervisor.

I attest that I have earned a high school diploma or its equivalent.

I attest that the subjects required by law will be offered in the English language.

I attest that the student has received the immunizations required by law, or that the student has a medical, religious, or philosophical exemption.

I attest that each child in the home education program has received the health and medical services required by law for students of the child's age or grade level and that a comprehensive health record is being maintained for each child.

I attest that no adult living in the home, or any person having legal custody of the student, has been convicted within five years of today's date of any of the criminal offenses enumerated in Section 111 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes.

I attest that the home education program shall comply with the provisions of Section 13-1327.1 of Pennsylvania Statutes Annotated and that the notarized affidavit shall be satisfactory evidence thereof.

Attached is:

1. Outline of the proposed education objectives by subject area.
2. Evidence that each child has been immunized or has a regular or medical exemption from immunizations.
3. Evidence of supervisor's graduation from high school or college or attainment of a general equivalency diploma (GED).
4. If a child in the home education program has been identified pursuant to the provisions of the education of the handicapped act as needing special education services, excluding those students identified as gifted and talented, then also attached is written notification of approval from a Pennsylvania-certified special education teacher, or a licensed clinical psychologist, or a certified school psychologist that this program addresses the specific needs of the student.
